

WSET Level 2 Professional Certificate in Spirits

Minimum age requirement 18 at time of booking

The WSET Level 2 Professional Certificate in Spirits is intended to provide a thorough knowledge of spirits and liquors to underpin job skills and competencies for example in customer service and sales in hospitality, retail, wholesale and spirits industry.

No previous experience in spirits is required and this course is appropriate for students who have a professional interest in spirits, and those who wish to broaden their knowledge of this fascinating subject. The Professional Certificate in spirits covers the history production and styles of principal spirits and liqueurs of the world. Each session will include a comparative product tasting.

Examination is by a one-hour multiple-choice examination on the final day.

(Please note that this syllabus is included within the Level 4 Diploma qualification and therefore students are not required to make a separate booking to attend this course as well).

The London Wine & Spirit School recommends that students complete at least 14 hours of personal study prior to commencing the course. It is strongly recommended that anyone wishing to attend the consecutive day programme book in sufficient time to receive the study materials a minimum of two weeks prior to the commencement of the course.
